**ORDER**

As per letters read as 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above, the Secretary, Kerala State Social Welfare Board and the Director of Social Justice respectively have submitted proposal for providing an additional honorarium as State share to the staffs of Short Stay Homes. Short Stay Home is an effective programme for the protection of women under various difficult circumstances - domestic violence, family problems, atrocities etc. There are 5 Short Stay Homes in the State under the Kerala State Social Welfare Board and it is a project with budget allocation of the Central Social Welfare Board as follows:

2. As per the letter read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above, the Director of Social Justice has opined that the present honorarium paid to the above employees is very meagre and insufficient when considering the nature of work and work load and has hence requested to provide an additional

honorarium as State Share to the staffs of Short Stay Homes till a revision is made by the Central Government. The proposal is as follows:
